This copy of an inquest into the "extenta" of Scriven in 1302 is among the Slingsby papers, compartment B12, bundle II, provisionally numbered 6. It is, perhaps, the earliest account in any detail which we have of Scriven and its inhabitants, and presents a very curious picture.

ANALYSIS OF EXTANTA SCRIVEN, 1302

(from the Excheator's bundle for the 28th Edward I, No. 44)

This is actually part of the Inquest Post Mortem of Edmund Earl of Cornwall, son of
Richard, brother of Henry III.

Edmund died in 1300 possessed of the Honor of Knaresborough. The inquest
seems to have opened at Borobridge, 11 January 1299-1300, Edmund having died
the preceding October 1.

(Yorkshire Inquisitions, iii. 126 and notes). It was continued at Knaresborough on
the 2nd January, 1300-1301, or perhaps I ought to say resumed (or supplemented),
as this is a year later. The reference to this in Yorkshire Inquis. lii, 131 – the morrow
of the Circumcision, 29 Edward, - is the exact reference given in the actual text of
this Extent (FN430). This membrane quoted "No. 44" 9FN430) in apparently that at

the beginning of the Inquest – 28. Edward I No. 144 (York. Inq iii. P 126), though the actual membrane bearing the Scriven account would seem to be £m.34” (cf. Yorks. Inq. P 131, head of the page), a discrepancy not easy to explain, seeing that this record is a year later than the other apparently. Probably the explanation is that the membranes as filled up were attached to the faces of the immediately preceding membrane, and not, as now would be the practice, at the back. The most recent rolls in the bundle would, therefore, be at the front, and at the best place for immediate reference.
