10 This list of Toll Cards is the latest that I have yet found among the town's records. It was drawn for, or voted, in or about 1742, as nearly as I can make out, to be spread over the next five or six years, for which there are separate yearly lists in the succeeding pages of the Town's Ledger. In the course of those years some changes in the personnel, some deaths and so forth must have taken place.

This list may be compared with that of 1730, (FN199), which appears to be the earliest formal one, and others, more or less difficult to make out, which are earlier. This one is late enough to connect up with the earliest of the continuous series of Assessment Lists (cf. FN 428)

20 Wee present the Severall houses hereafter mentioned to be intituled to TollCards within the Burrough of Knaresbrough Afforesaid those marked with the Letter B being for Burgages and freehold and those marked with the Letter W being for Coppinghold and Customary houses, those marked with B to pay one Shilling for the Card and those marked with W to pay one Shilling and Six pence for theirs.
