Blacksmith's Cottage	<p>Built in the first half of the eighteenth century not as a farmhouse but as a craftsman's dwelling – the forge was traditionally on the Green. It is built of gritstone rubble of two bays with the front door in the left hand bay just left of centre.</p> <p>The ground floor front has two windows each side of the front door both being twentieth century side sliding sashes of two lights with sixteen panes.</p> <p>The first floor front has two- light four-pane twentieth century side sliding sash to the left and a two-light twelve pane sliding sash to the right.</p> <p>The first floor windows have wooden window lintels while the ground floor are arched and made of brick.</p> <p>The roof is stone slate with a brick built stack at each end.</p>
