It is stone built, stone faced with pantile roof. ' LIVING ROOM. Yorkist type Range and Back Boiler. Built in Cupboard with Shelves under. Power Point. SITTING ROOM. Modern tiled Fireplace. Display Shelving. Power Point. KITCHEN. Single drainer Sink. Gas and Electric Points. Cupboard under stairs. Larder. Back Hall and lean-to Store Room. THREE GOOD BEDROOMS, two with Power Points. BATHROOM. Panelled Bath. Bracket Washbasin. High level W.C. Airing Cupboard with Hot Water Cylinder. OUTSIDE : Brick built Coal House. Store Shed. Workshop. Small Garden.
A History of Scriven	1 and 2 The Green was probably a single house with the door at the back and a window into the chimney corner.
Corner Cottage along with 1& 2 Village Terrace & The Old Smithy.	Numbers 1 and 2 Village Terrace. A six paneled door stands left of centre and at the far left there is a blocked doorway with a small paned window inserted. There are twentieth century frames throughout. There are dentilled eaves cornice and a large brick to the right of centre. The rear wall is of stone rubble construction. Interior: The door opens onto the side of back-to-back fireplaces with timber lintels. There is a timber framed stud partition visible at first floor level. This house was probably the principal hall range or a hall cross-wing plan facing south.
