#### History Summary

The building existed in mid 19th century and was described as Infants school yard and wash in 1839 Tithe allocation. Subsequently it was shown as kennels and other than changing its configuration over the years remains today, early 21st century. In 1987 the kennels and surrounding land was sold with planning permission for conversion to residential use.

1834 Parish Road and Drain Upkeep Rate Schedule  
The Dog Kennels Sale      Not data for Plan Number 243

A most unusual 18th century estate building with planning permission for residential conversion, in about 1.25 acres. The former Dog Kennels which are thought to date from about 1800 are of stone and pantile construction with characteristic tall gothic windows. It is believed that they were originally built by Sir Charles Slingsby the local estate owner and master of the York & Ainsty Hunt. Following his death in the 1869 River Ure tragedy when the ferry boat capsized, this use was discontinued and the building used for agricultural purposes.
