Item Description BOAT HOUSE

Site Data

This structure is a Boat House standing on the NW side of Appelby Carr, between the lake bank and the boundary wall. It is in a state of ruin. The building is three sided consisting of a back wall and two side walls. The walls are constructed with dressed sandstone of good quality on the outside but roughly dressed on the inner. Batons fixed to the inner skin show that it had a lath and plaster finish at some time. The back wall is 700mm thick, 4.2m long and 2.6m high. Centrally disposed on the inner surface of this wall is a fireplace 1.2m wide by 0.86m high with a wooden lintel, the brickwork above being of clamp bricks up to roof level. To the right of the fireplace is a cupboard recess 0.7m wide by 0.9m high and 0.65m deep. It has a wooden lintel and a brick sill. The interior of the cupboard has some remnants of horsehair plaster with evidence of ochre paint on it. The two side walls are 3.32m long by 2.6m high, both showing evidence of being plastered at some time. There is no roof on the building or remains of one within the building. Verbal evidence informs us that the building has always been three sided with a sloping roof and was thought to have been used by the Appleby Carr manager.

History Summary

The boat house is present in the mid 19th century and its remains exist in the early 21st century.
