Item Description FIELD

Site Data

This field is grassland, pasture and improved. It rises gently from the north boundary to a broad ridge running east/west and then slopes at a steeper gradient down to the southern. There is a line of mature trees in the eastern section running north /south along the line of an old field boundary. The north boundary is post and wire fence, the eastern is also post and wire standing against a set of steel railings which form the boundary of the adjacent enclosure. The southern boundary consists largely of a stone wall 2m high with a short section of the post and wire/railings at the eastern extent. The western boundary is a post and wire fence. Along the southern boundary, set back about 8m from the wall and standing on a bank, is a line of mature trees. Set between these there appear to be three or four building platforms. Visible in the central area of the field are the remains of ridge and furrow running north/south, approximately 9m crest to crest and most probably medieval. These are visible on an aerial photograph of 1966 as well as some in the northern sector running east/ west which are not visible on the ground. In the north east corner forming an arc about 100m long are the remains of a haha with the revetted wall standing 1m at the maximum with a ditch about 3m wide.

History Summary

The field remained unchanged from early 21st century until late 19th century but by mid 19th century the field no longer exists having been divided into 4 separate fields.

1839 Tithe Apportionment Scriven Study Area	Tithe fields 262, 263 and 264 were owned by Sir Charles Slingsby. The occupier of 262 was Benjamin Wrigglesworth, 263 William Steel and 264 Sir Charles Slingsby. 262 and 264 were known as Elias Field and 263 as a garden. All three fields were grassland. The areas were 262 2 acres 1 rood 2 square poles, 263 1 acre 3 roods 24 square poles and 264 4 acres 2 roods 36 square poles.
