This runs 110m W and from this W extremity a fence/boundary is marked running approximately 120m N, leaving a gap of 40m to the N boundary.

1965 July Scriven Sale Map	Field is unchanged. In the NE corner the partial enclosure is shown as fully enclosed. Approximately 25m S of the N boundary on the W boundary of the enclosed area are two 4-sided structures, possibly sheds and 100m from the N boundary is a similar structure W of this boundary. A pond 275 is shown 98m W of a point on the fields E boundary 180m S of the fields NE corner. The enclosed area is field 96 and the remainder of the field is field 98 of Sale Lot 7..
1965 September Scriven Sale Map	Field unchanged but only partial enclosure shown in NE corner.OS field number 7300, 5.14 hectares applies only to the field minus the enclosed area. A pond, 299, 12m x 8m is located on the fields S boundary 154m from its SW corner. The rectangular features of July map are not shown.

1950 OS Map Scriven	Unchanged. The 3 rectangular features of July 1965 map are shown as are ponds 275 and 299. It is possible that the two adjacent rectangular features are ponds, 273 and 274, and the other rectangular feature is probably a shed.
1941 RAF/4E/UK689 Run V Frame 9157	Unchanged field and NE enclosure. Ponds 273, 274 and 299 visible. Pond 275 not visible. Indication of a track from a point on the N boundary 30m W of the NE corner to 24m S of the two ponds 273 and 274.

1938 OS Map Scriven	Unchanged but no track and L shaped building , 300 just to the W of wooded area on S boundary

1907 OS Map Scriven	Area of field is divided into 7 enclosures. Along the E boundary and in the C and E section of the S boundary is tree-lined and the 45m E of the W boundary and 125m N of the S boundary a Pump, 301 is shown. On either side of the W boundary of the enclosure in the NE corner of the field and approximately 30m S of the N boundary are two 4-sided structures. 95m W from the field's E boundary and approximately 100m S of the N boundary is a kidney-shaped/circular feature. Approximately 25m E of the Pump and in the SW corner of the enclosure N of Guiseley Hill Plantation is an L-shaped building 300, measuring 12m x 30m.

1854 First Edition	Unchanged with 9 enclosures by the creation of 2 new enclosures at the N boundary. All 4 ponds are shown and pond 274 shows a stream running in a NE direction to the fields N boundary. In the NW corner of the field a "shed" is noted. Field 32 has been incorporated into field 28 but there are only 2 small plantations along the field's E boundary
1849 Scriven	The E half of the field comprising 6 enclosures is shown and are unchanged. To the N of the enclosure W of the enclosure in the NE corner is a rectangular enclosure measuring 100m x 20m. Guiseley Hill and Guiseley Hill Plantation, in the central section of the S boundary, are marked. The boundaries of the enclosures are shown as tree-lined. On either side of the W boundary of the enclosure in the NE corner , approximately 30m S of the N boundary are two ponds 273 and 274 in an enclosure approximately 18 square m. A track 297 to the structure to the E of the boundary lies approximately 40m from the N boundary, approximately 100 m W of the NE corner of the field. To the E of this footpath are rectangular features, possibly enclosures. Some 90m S of pond 275 is a new pond 302.
1839 Tithe map	In the field are 8 enclosures which bear tithe numbers 268, 292, 293, 294, 295, 296, 297 and 298.
