The area has 20 buildings including 6 of significant architecture. From E to W these six are Park Corner Farmhouse,98, Spinney Croft, 152, Oak Lea, 153, Home Farmhouse, 154, Rose Cottage, 155, and Old Coach house, 162, now known as Scriven Hall and named as Hall on map. The scale of the map does not allow each house to be shown separately. The named buildings are shown on every relevant map or aerial photo unless sated otherwise.
