History Summary

In mid 19th century this area of the village was agricultural land of some 13 fields. By the end of the 19th century the expansion of the village of Scriven had begun and the S extent of the land was developed to create what is now part of New Scriven. Through the first half of the 20th century this S area was completed and by the 1980's the remainder of the area was developed.

1854 First Edition	<p>There are no dwellings in the area and it is now divided into 13 fields. The field in the NW corner is named as the Smelt Field. There are two barns approx 110m W fo w boundary and 23m and 120m S of N boundary. Three ponds are shown, one on the W boundary, named as Smelt Pond, 124m from NW corner of field, a second on the E boundary some 24m from the NE corner and a third 203m from the N boundary and 130m from the W boundary.A stream runs SE for 70m from the W pond, then 42m E, 35m S to the pond in the centre of the field before continuing E for 140m, NNE for 40m, E for 25m and finally NE for 22m to exit the field on the E boundary. A track crosses the NW corner of the field from a point on the W boundary, 190m from the NW corner to a point on the N boundary, 100 from the NW corner. Where the track crossses the stream there is a footbridge.</p>
1849 Scriven	<p>Little changed from 1854. Small number of the fields have benn subdivided and a third barn is shown on the W boundary, 180m from the S point of the field.</p>
1839 Tithe map	<p>Only 9 fields are shown and only 8 of them have Tithe field numbers, 284 - 291. The two fields in the SE corner together equate to Tithe field 291.The track is shown as is the central barn.</p>
1834 Parish Plan – Road and Drain Upkeep Rate	<p>Again 9 fields are shown but only 8 Plan Nmbers 213 - 220. The two fields in SE corner equate to Plan number 213 and have Knaresborough written across them. The track and both the central and N barns are shown.</p>

Study Area

Tithe fields 284, 285, 286, 287 and 291 are owned by Sir Charles Slingsby and fields 288, 289 and 290 are owned by Richard Henry Roundell. All fields are grassland. Field 284, Green Gates, is occupied by Robert Goodall and is of area 2 acres 3 roods 13 sq poles. Field 285, Marshalls Close, is occupied by Alice Marshaw and is of area 4 acres 2 roods 32 sq poles. Field 286, Smelt Close is occupied by Thomas Steel and is of area 4 acres 4 roods 4 sq poles. Field 287, Moors Close, is occupied by John Tarbotton and is of area 2 acres 1 rood 32 sq poles. Field 288, Thirlsbeck, is occupied by Matthew Lumley and is of area 3 acres 6 sq poles. Field 289, Low Durham Willows, is occupied by John Linforth and is of area 2 acres 1 roods 1 sq poles. Field 290, High Durham, is occupied by Joseph Scruton and is of area 4 acres 3 roods 18 sq poles. Field 291, Town End Close, is occupied by John Meadley and is of area 3 acres 1 roods 25 sq poles.
