History Summary

This area of the village to the N of Greengate Lane and the E of the Green was largely farm land in the mid 19th century with houses along part of its S and W boundaries and it remained so until the mid 20th century. By early 1970's the W extent of the area had been developed for housing but with the central area had become a nursery. By the start of the 21st century the area occupied by the nursery had been developed for housing.

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Description	Comments
2008 Scriven OS Map	The E extent of the Old Village. An rectangular area with dimensions of 238m x 95m, alignment E, area 2.19 hectares. Within the area are 18 buildings although the scale of the map does not allow details of all separate buildings. There are 6 buildings of architectural significance and these from S to N are No 1 The Green, 189, No 2 The Green, 188, Corner Cottage, 163, Old Smithy, 190, Roundells Manor, 161 and Earls Cottage, 164. All these named buildings are on all relevant maps or aerial photos unless stated otherwise.
