#### Site Data

This field consists of improved pasture grassland, it is flat at the at the western extent and then slopes to the east ending in a steeper bank of rough grass. The boundaries are post and wire fence with a narrow a narrow strip of mature trees on the northern edge. There are the remains of an old limestone quarry in the north east corner and several small limestone quarries adjacent to the south eastern boundary. Running north east across the slope of the field in the south eastern extent are a number of low profile lyncett banks most probably of medieval origen and centered on GR 435094 458749.

#### History Summary

From the early 21st century until the late 1960's the field remained unchanged but in the mid 1960's it was merged with field 39 to its E. By the late 19th century an enclosure is seen in the NW of the field and by the mid 19th century the field is separated into 5 fields

A field to the east of this measures 168 x 118m. Two fields at the south measure 100 x 147m and 88 x 145m respectively. An old sandstone quarry (No. 6094137) is marked. Tracks 226 and 229 are shown but 226 is to the E of the boundary of the two new Eastern fields rather than within the boundary of field 40.
