Item Description FIELD

Site Data

This field consists of semi-improved pasture grassland. It rises in a gentle slope from west to east with a steeper slope at the eastern extent. The boundaries are a mixture of hedge and post and wire fence with an area of woodland abutting the north eastern corner and also at the south western. The field as recorded on the maps has been bisected by a post and wire fence running north. At the eastern extent in the area of the steepest slope are a number of lyncett banks running north and centred on GR 434650 458930 and most probably medieval in origin. In the same area and apparently post dating the lyncett banks are a sand and a sand stone quarry. On the flatter ground in the western extent are the remains of an old trackway running north and appearing as a low profile causeway.

History Summary

The field remained unchanged from the early 21st century until the mid 1970's when it was divided into three fields and by 1970 it no longer exists.

Track 115 appears to continue N on a new path to join track 286. A linear feature, probably a line of a watercourse, 290, runs from the NW corner of the field to a point on the S boundary 90m W of the SE corner of the field.

There is a linear feature, part of the boundary shown in 1973 Frame 2673 AP, from Market Flat Lane 90m from SW corner running NE for 98m and stops 111m from S boundary. Only quarry 126 marked. Watercourse 290 not shown.

Quarry 126 is named Gravel Pit and quarry 133 named Old Quarry (Sandstone). The area either side of the stream in its N extent is shown as a marshy area as seen on the 1941 aerial photo.
