#### Site Data

This field is an arable enclosure that at the time of inspection had been part ploughed , part harrowed and part sown. It is bounded on the north by a hedge and a post and wire fence and at the east by another post and wire fence and woodland. The southern boundary is also post and wire fence and woodland. The eastern boundary is formed at the southern extent by the post and wire fence and fragmented wall of Appleby Carr and to the north by a hedge and post and wire fence contiguous with Preston Bottoms Lane. Historic maps indicate a trackway running parallel with and immediately to the south of the northern boundary. There is ,however, little sign of this feature apart from a small section of about 10m at the east end where is a raised bank and a suggestion of vehicle wheel marks. A significant scatter of stones in the soil along the line of the track indicates its original position. The track marked on the historic maps as running adjacent to and parallel with the southern boundary is still in place and still used. There appear to be no other features visible in the field which has clearly been the subject of much ploughing. Ariel photographs, however indicate traces of probably Romano-British field systems.

#### History Summary

The present field remained unchanged until the 1970's when it was divided into two fields. Thereafter no changes occurred until the mid 19th century when it was merged with two other fields.
