Site Data

This enclosure is a paddock measuring 80x83m situated beside a large bungalow in Estate Road named Slingsby Lodge. The north boundary is formed by a strip of woodland with a post and wire fence. The eastern is a wooden rail fence and the southern is a hedge. The western boundary is formed by the edge of High Wood. The ground rises gently to the north eastern corner. There are a few ornamental trees in the southern section. Across the centre running north/south are the remains of a trackway, 242, surviving now as a low profile causway about 3m wide and turf covered. At the northern extent, adjacent to the boundary, are what appear to be the remains of building platforms covering an area of approximately 13x5m and lying between GR 434540 458562 and GR 434553 458554. These may be associated with the WWII Prisoner of War camp or may be earlier.

History Summary

A field created in the early years of the second half of the 20th century and survives in the early 21st century.
