Track 114 runs NE from Market Flat Lane 50m from the W end of the S boundary to meet track 112 on the N boundary. Track 113 runs in an E direction from the N point of track 112. Hazelhead farmhouse, a listed building is shown in the S part of the field together with other farm buildings and a building is shown to thw W of track 114. The field is divided into a number of enclosures.
