Title **Indenture of Thomas Lightfoot.**

West Riding Comitt Ebor.

10 This Indenture Witnesseth, that the Church-Wardens and Oversees of the Poor of
Scriven com Tentergate (in the parish of Knaresbrough. Have with the assent, Consent,
Allowance and Approbation, of two of Her Majesties Justices of the Peace within the
said Rideing whose Names are Subscribed (one being of the Quorum) put placed and
bound Thomas Lightfoot of township aforesaid a Poor Child about the age of eleven
years Apprentice with Jonathan Keighley of your said Town to dwell and remain from
the Date of these presents for during and until the said Apprentice shall attain and come
to the age of Twenty four years According to the Term of the Statute in that Case
provided, in the Forty Third Year of the Reign of Queen Elizabeth. By and during all
which Time and Tearn; the said Apprentice shall his said Master well and faithfully
serve, in all such Lawful business as the said Apprentice shall be put unto, according to
his Power, Wits, and Ability. AND honestly, and obediently in all things shall behave
himself towards his master his Wife, Children, and Family. AND the said Jonathan
20 Keighley for hispart do hereby Covenant, to find unto the said Apprentice, Meat, Drink,
and Apparel, Lodging, Linnen, Washing, And all other things, meet and needful for such
an Apprentice. AND also to bring up the said Apprentice in the Fear of God, and some
Lawful Calling, during the said Tearn. In Witness whereof, the said Church-Wardens,
and Overseers of the Poor have hereunto set their Hands and Seals, the Twenty Third
day of February in the Seventh year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Queen Ann,
Over England, &, Annoq; Dom, 1708/9.
