25 shall be permitted or suffered to continue or abide there unless fferiners or
26 strangers shall first enter into sufficient security to the Captitall pledges there for the
27 time being that they nor any of them by themselves wives children or familye shall be
28 anywayes chargeable or troublesome to the other inhabitants of the said Townshipp
29 by way of begging or otherwise. And whereas the above bounden George Morrell
30 and Henry Thirkell being fforiners and Strangers are now comed to inhabit and dwell
31 within the said Townshipp. Now if the said George Morrell and Henry Thirkell or
32 either of them by themselves wives children or familys or by any of their abode within
33 the said Townshipp shall not from time to time be anywayes chargeable or
34 troublesome to any other the Inhabitants or Resiants within the said Townshipp by
35 way of begging or otherwise That then this obligation to be void and of none effect or
36 else to be and remain in full force and virtue.

18 William Briggs and his successor overseers of the poore and all other the inhabitants
19 of Scriven aforesaid their heirs Executors admrtors of and from all manner of
20 damages Charges harmes or incombrances, which shall or may att any tyme
21 hereafter happen arise or grow against them or any of them for or by reason of such
22 their residence or abode Then this obligation to be void or also to remain in full
23 power and force
