### Tree Data Summary

T.P.O.

This tree has a vertical split in the trunk to the height of 5m. This split is in the east/west direction on the north side of the trunk is a large branch pointing in the north direction at a height of 3m. This branch is in full bloom with many branches from this main branch. Very little dead wood.

To the south side of the tree is a main branch at 5m. This branch is pointing in a north direction and is in full bloom with very little dead wood.

Above the point of 5m the main trunk is dead and it extends to a height of 9m with dead branches projecting from this trunk.

On the south facing trunk below the level of 5m there are a number of branches growing in a south direction but one branch has grown with leaves but has now died back with dead branches and leaves.

Amount of dead wood in this section of the trunk and branches is 50%.
