Site Data

This is situated on the western slope of Coney Garth and above Quarry One. It consists of degraded Triassic Sandstone deposited by glacial melt water and takes the form of several large pits cut into the hill side and now almost entirely turf covered. It is partly exposed as a result of badgers constructing a set and kicking out the sand. It has clearly been used in the past as source of building sand. The field is apparently known as "Sand Burrow"

History Summary

The quarry was named Gravel Pit in the mid 19th century and its remains are visible today, early 21st century.
