Item Description QUARRY

Site Data

This is situated on the western slope of the Coney Garth Plateau. This feature has a limestone cap overlying a layer of carboniferous rocks which outcrop in places. The quarry has an exposed face about ten metres in length and about three metres high at the maximum. It is partly overgrown with vegetation and trees and is weathered. It has been cut into a bed of Lower Plumpton Grit stone. This is coarse and pebbly in the upper layers but finer in the lower. It was probably deposited by a river channel with the material drawn from some distance. It was most likely used as a source of building stone and probably originated in the 18th century. The band of stone is likely to be about 22 metre thick There was a fox hole at the base.

History Summary

A sandstone quarry described as Old Sandstone Quarry in mid 19th Century with its remains there until early 21st Century.
