Site Data

This earthwork is in the form of a Ditch and Bank at the western end of Scriven Park and runs through Wood 60940014 and Field 60940013. At its north eastern extent (GR 434365 458478) the ditch is 0.6m deep with the bank on the southern side to a height of 1.2m. The bank at this location is possibly the edge of a very large building platform. The ditch runs south-west for a distance of 13m following the edge of the building platform the begins to swing south for a further 26m where it has been backfilled where it would have crossed the track at GR 434307 458424, which runs from the estate road to Field 60940061 which lies to the north-east. The bank and ditch continues 3.0m south-west of this track the ditch depth now being 0.9m deep and the bank 1.2m high. This earthwork continues running west-south-west through the centre of the wood until it meets a large "sink hole" at GR 434047 458398 into which the ditch merges. The bank is still present along the southern rim of the "sink hole". The "sink hole" is 12m in diameter and 4.5m deep. On the south-south-west side of the "sink hole" the bank and ditch reappear. At GR 433934 458358 the line of the bank and ditch crosses a trackway which links Fields 60940018 and 60940061 which lie south and north respectively at which point the ditch and bank have been levelled. 5m to the south-south-west of this track the ditch and bank continues to NGR 433878 458345 where it swings to the south and runs to NGR 433790 458321 where it exits the wood to enter Field 60940013. The ditch and bank now runs parallel to the north-west boundary of this field, the ditch being the boundary with a hawthorne hedge in the bottom. At the western corner of this field the bank swings to the south-east to follow the field boundary. This ditch and bank is possibly the late medieval western boundary linked with the first manor house in Scriven.

History Summary

The SW corner of the earthwork was used as an enclosure boundary in the mid 19th century and is visible to various extents on aerial photos throughout the second half of the 20th century and early 21st century
