Description

Russian Bale Sal, Narva, Estonia 1804. Bulla type seal. These seals are Russian flax bale quality control seals. The 'NP' may stand for the port of Narva in Estonia. Circular in shape with a double hole all the way through for cord.

Ob: Line 1: Port Initials

Line 2: Codified data, probably identifying the producer

Line 3: Date

Rev: Line 1: Initials?

Line 2: Initial and surname of quality control officer.

The dates of this type of seal appear to run approx from 1740 to 1840. The numbers could refer to tariff or more frequently hemp quality. eg. 9-head of 12-head.
