Description

Thimble made from copper alloy. The thimble has a slightly domed top and flares towards the base. 17mm long and 20mm wide at its widest point. The domed top is indented with small diamond shapes, the sides are indented with dot shapes. There is a ridge around the base 1mm wide with a narrow channel above 1.5mm wide containing a simple pattern which is unidentifiable. The thimble is complete but slightly compressed. Good condition with a brownish green patina.
