Description

95% intact quernstone. Beehive Type 2 sub round. Single G/S edge impact + 3-4 'nibbles' (removed 30% of G/S edge). G/S - apparently two phases of wear - ca 50% of circumference is worn flat, max width 40mm, in a crescentic shape - with an inner 140-150mm radius worn concave - max 10mm depth. Outer surface neatly hammer dressed. The absence of the Phase 1 Flat G/S on the side of the quern with the asymmetric side profile may be explained by that side of the stone being recut, prior to use with a 300mm diameter upper stone? The quern is an oval shape with triangular spindle hole.
