Description

Quern stone fragment possibly beehive type. 4% edge fragment. External surface neatly hammer dressed, impacts 10-15 mm diameter, 3mm deep. Likley to indicatge a lower stone (as uppers are generally more finished). G/S flat. Abraded state of fracture edges indicates considerable wear after breakage. Diameter estimated from 17cm of circumference - 450mm. 50kg are exceptionally large for a beehive quern, which are typically 27-33cm diameter for upperrs & 30-36cm diameter for based. Thus, if this is from a beehive, it is most probably from an oval base stone.
