Description

95% intact, single G/S edge impact +3-4 "nibbles" (removed on 30% of G/S edge). G?S appafrently two phases of wear. 50% of circumference is worn flat, max width 40mm, in a concentric shape with an inner 140-150mm radius worn concave - max 10mm depth. Outer surface neatly hammer dressed. Medium/large grained gritstone with quarz pebbles, probably Millstone Grit. The absence of the Phase 1 flat G/S on the wide of the quern with the assymetric side profile may be explained by that side of the stone being recut, prior to use with a 300mm diameter upper stone? Triangular spindle.
