Description

Oval quern stone. External surface neatly hammer dressed, impacts 10-15 median, 3mm deep - likely to indicate a lower stone (as uppers are generally more finished). G/S flat. Abraded state of fracture edges indicates considerable wear after breakage. Diameter estimated from 17cm of circumference - 450mm & 50kg are exceptionally large for a beehive quern, which are typically 27-33cm dia for upper and 30-36cm dia for bases. Thus, if this is from a beehive, it is most probably from an oval base stone.
