Quern fragment - 60%. Upper part of hopper completely removed leaving inclined scar. Major impact removed ca 20% of GS edge, including handle. Flat, worn surface, initially random pecked. Outer surface, neatly peck dressed. Hopper apparently narrow, deep and slightly concave. Replacement of handle hole A by higher hole B indicates this is a well worn stone.
