Description

80% intact quernstone. Large chordal fracture & G/S damage to handle hole. Ca 40% of G/S edge removed. Exterior surface peck dressed with rounded top to hopper. G/S Concave (20mm). The drilled feedpipe has rough depression. Main fracture had subsequently been roughly peck dressed. Reddish brown, fine grained sandstone. Its large diameter and concave G/S are typological features of Developed Beehive querns, likely to be dated to the early centuries of the 1st millennium AD.
