Beehive conical quern stone 95% survival. 8-10 impacts on G/S edge has removed 85% of outer edge. Exterior surface - smooth surface - straight sided cone. Curved edge at the hopper top, chipped by at least 3 impacts. G/S flat, worn smooth. Medium to coarse grained, grey millstone grit.
