### Description

Beehive hemisphere quern stone. 70% survival - two impacts on the handle holes & massive chordal removal. Ca 60% of G/S edge removed and portion of hopper removed. Exterior neatly peck dressed. Hopper is assymmetric and F/P appears off centre. Spindle worn ridge 40mm up F/P. G/S distinctly concave, with outer lip; linear grooves near the F/P may be plough damage, suggesting deposition with G/S uppermost. Grey, fine grained millstone grit. Concave G/S typologically Developed Beehive, indicating early 1st millennium AD dating.
