<b>Description</b>						
<p>Stamped, flat sectioned copper alloy mounts (2), dating from the Post Medieval period. There are two objects of similar form and design, differing only in the better state of preservation of one half of one of the mounts. The mounts probably fitted onto a strap by means of the integral tags which curve backwards from the face. In plan, the mounts are rectangular with an ovoid terminal. The attaching tag is subtriangular on the ovoid terminal; it is rectangular in plan with a curved terminal at the opposite end. Decoration comprises curved solid lines, in low relief, alternating with lines of small, stylised tulip like low relief marks. The background to the motif shows as very small, slightly raised and regular dimples. All of this is seen in a mirrored form from the reverse of the mounts. One of the mounts had been nestled beside the other in such a way that the motif has been preserved where it was covered. Corrosion has erased the majority of the motif on both mounts.</p>
