### Description

Stamped, flat sectioned copper alloy mount dating from the Post Medieval period. The mount probably fitted onto a strap by means of the integral tags which curve backwards from the face. In plan, the mount is rectangular with an ovoid terminal; it is rectangular in plan with a curved terminal at the opposite end. Decoration comprises a foliate border with two flowers in the centre, one above the other. The background of the mount comprises extremely low relief longitudinal, parallel striations. The reverse shows a mirrored version of the relief pattern.
