Dark metal disk, punched hole at top. Where the object is abraded the material seems to be brass underneath. The object is extremely thin. Side 1: pattern indistinct. Triple bordered diamond pattern with a suggestion of pattern outside the border. Side 2: Traingular motif, not aligned with punched hole. Double border with a medial row of pellets. The object may have been cut from a large sheets. It could be a badge or amulet possibly indicating membership or allegiance. Recommended to be professionally cleaned.
