**Item Description** POND

#### Site Data

This pond is named Appleby Carr and has been used for recreational purposes for many years. The lake is sub-elliptical measuring 122m at its widest point by 95m at its narrowest and covering an area of approximately 0.89 hectares. Centrally disposed in the lake is a sub-circular island measuring some 37m in diameter and covering 0.11 hectares. This island is artificial and thought to be the result of piling up the silt from the bed of the lake during the deepening process. From discussion with the lake manager it would appear that the lake was originally four to five feet deep and as fish stocks were depleting it was necessary to drain of the water to excavate a further six to seven feet from the lake bed. It was found at this point that the bed was solid clay and not puddled as at first thought and four sumps twenty feet deep were dug out to improve the water quality. The silt and clay that was dug out was spread around the banks and on the central island and at the same time a small number of mature trees on the island were felled.

#### History Summary

Appleby Carr existed in the mid 19th century and remains today, early 21st century.
