10 My real estate in Scriven to John Poulter of Scriven, Linen Weaver, and David Lewis of Belmont near Knaresborough, Yeoman, Upon Trust, to allow my wife to occupy the same for ten years, and to receive the profits for the support of my children. If she should remarry or allow her parents to live with her then my Trustees are immediately to dispose of same. This money to be divided amongst my sons John Surr, Joseph Surr, and George Surr, and my daughter Jane Surr.

After ten years my real estate to go to my son John, chargeable with £8 each to my sons Joseph and George, and £6 each to my children Jane Surr, Ann Surr, Margaret Surr, William Surr, and Richard Surr.
