Salary Thirty Pounds a Year with, Meat, Washing, &c. A Man without a Family would be preferred and Testimonials of Character will be required. The day of election is on the *fifth day of April next*, at the House of Mrs. Clayton, Royal Oak Inn, Bond-end, Knaresbro', At Two o'Clock in the Afternoon. – Scriven-with-Tentergate, March 15<sup>th</sup>, 1832.
